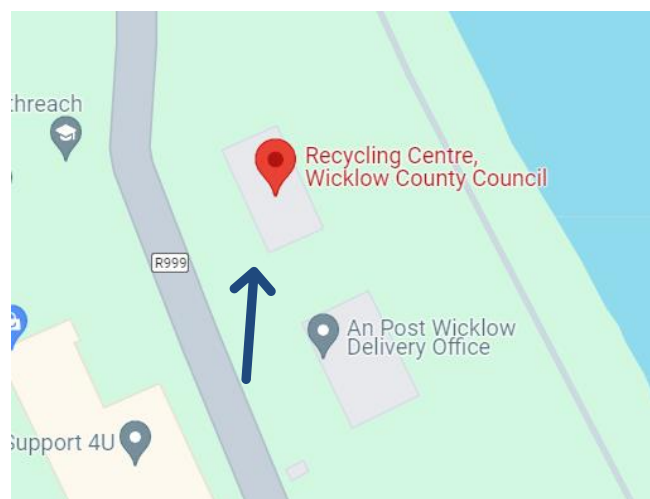

## When Using the Centre

- Household use only, commercial waste will not be accepted on site.
  - To comply with Health and Safety Regulations users of this facility must exercise due care.
- Children must be supervised at all times.
  - Dogs must always be on a lead.
- Cardboard must be clean & flattened if possible.
- Glass should be clean, lids removed & colour sorted.
- Cans should be clean & sorted by type – food/drinks.
  - Clothing should be clean.
  - Shoes should be in pairs.
- All waste must be placed in the correct receptacle.
- Material should not be removed from the facility.
