TopicResidential Development **Submission**

Lower Rathnew is classified entirely within Flood Zones A and B, which represent areas at high risk of flooding. The existing and proposed developments, including roads and housing situated either directly within or just above these flood-prone zones, exacerbate the susceptibility to future flooding events. This is due to increased surface runoff and reduced capacity for water infiltration caused by the expansion of impermeable surfaces in these areas.

Although this heightened flood risk has been acknowledged in planning documents, a waiver of responsibility has been included, effectively absolving those responsible from accountability for any future flooding impacts arising from these developments. This raises concerns about the long-term sustainability and safety of the area as further construction proceeds.

Additionally, while the inclusion of a pump house to mitigate flooding has been referenced in the plans, no definitive location has been established. Alarmingly, the proposed sites for the pump house are themselves located within flood-prone zones, further undermining its potential effectiveness. Without a clear and well-thought-out strategy for flood mitigation infrastructure, the area remains vulnerable to significant flooding incidents in the future.

Recent objection by ABP recently stated that the local area of Rathnew is over zoned and that there is sufficient housing for the area. It seems ridiculous that you see fit to include 4 story apartment blocks and more and more houses. What we don't have is sufficient services to meet the demand of the rising number of houses being built in the area. A mother advised that her child is 105th on waiting list for CCM, all the locals schools have waiting lists including the Gaelscoil. A friend today advised that there was a 6 week wait time for a Dr's appointment in Westmount clinic..where are all these additional people going to go school, dentist, GPS.
