I have noticed a deeply concerning trend (mostly online Wicklow town forum) around school places for children. There is a nasty and sinister narrative prevalent on this forum which is pitting children of families who are local (Wicklow town born and bred) against children of families in the local area who have moved in recently. I was very shocked to see this sentiment being shared openly online 2 nights ago on the Wicklow town facebook Forum. There seems to be the thinking that children of parents who have been born and bred in Wickow town themelves should have priority over children who have moved in recently. All children living in the local area deserve school places. As someone who works with children daily I find this way of thinking deeply alarming and it is sowing seeds of division between parents.

I do think the rate of residential development in Wicklow town/Rathnew is causing extreme pressure on essential services such as GP, Dental services and school places.

This is allowing a dangerous rhetoric to take traction which is thriving when parents cant get school places for their children or have been left on extensive waiting lists for oversubscribed schools. I do think this needs to be taken into consideration when approving future residential developments in the Wicklow Town/Rathnew area.
